A wrestler must be a current registered AAU member and go to school in the State of Missouri to be eligible to compete in the Missouri AAU State Wrestling Championships.

## ADMISSION

Admission is free to all wrestling fans and spectators.

## DIVISIONS

**Gold Division:** For wrestlers with less than one (1) year experience.

**Blue Division:** Open to any competitor meeting age requirement but is intended for wrestlers with more than one (1) year experience.

## AGES & WEIGHTS

Wrestlers must weigh-in at their scheduled time and make their "scratch weight" with no weight allowance. **Wrestlers are required to weigh in with a singlet and hair cover (if necessary).** There will be no early or late weigh-ins and no changing weight classes. **Please put exact weight for heavyweight wrestlers.**

Double elimination, MSHSAA (Folk Style) match rules will apply. Length of bouts for Bantam, Midget, Novice (1, 1, 1). Schoolboy, Cadet and High school (2, 1, 1). Only AAU certified wrestling coaches allowed on mats.

The Blue division seeding meeting will be held at Crestview Middle School (16025 Clayton Road, Ellisville, MO 63011) on Tuesday, February 22 at 7:00 PM in the cafeteria. We will only complete the seeding for the Blue division Brackets. Brackets will be completed and posted online by 10 PM on February 23.

Gold and High School divisions are randomly drawn into brackets, not seeded. If you have a fist year wrestler who should be seeded, we suggest wrestling them in the Blue division. Brackets will be completed and posted online by 10PM on February 23.

## WRESTLER ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$25 per wrestler. All wrestlers must be currently registered with the National AAU.

## INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION

Must register and pay online at [www.moaustate.com](http://www.moaustate.com). Click on MO AAU state and then registration. Individuals registering this way will not be associated with a team and will be considered unattached. The tournament will not accept mail registration for individuals.

## AWARDS

Gold Division - Medals to top 6 wrestlers.

Blue Division - Trophy to Champion and medals for 2<sup>nd</sup> -6<sup>th</sup>.

Blue Division - Plaque for "Most Falls by Champion" in each age group. The Champion with the most falls wins the plaque. Tiebreaker will be determined by the shortest combined time.

## TEAM SCORING

Blue division team scores are based on the top 6 places in each bracket. 6 points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 5 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> .... ,1 point for 6<sup>th</sup>.
